How to Write a Bio

Bios should be between 50 and 75 words (no more, no less). If space allows, and if warranted, Old Town Theatre will consider a bio that's a bit longer for audition purposes, but if choose to do this, you should submit a 50-75-word bio as well for printing in the program.

The bio should focus ONLY on your performance experience and /or basic information about yourself. It is about YOU.

The bio should NOT include personal "thanks" to family or instructors. (It is a bio, not an awards speech.)

OTT reserves the right to edit bios that are too short, too long or inappropriate for the production or event.

Your bio submission should include a headshot if possible. This can be a professional photo or a high quality personal photo of you.

All bios must be submitted electronically or typed and printed. HANDWRITTEN BIOS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

All Bios are due by posted dates. Please watch your calendar carefully to ensure you meet the deadline. Failure to submit your bio by deadline will result in your bio not being included in the Performance Program.
