

What to Pack in Your Theatre Supply Bag

Required

Overnight bag, laundry bag or tote bag to carry items in;
Any makeup required for the character, other than specialty;
Hair comb/brush – students are NOT allowed to share;
Hairspray, gel, etc. based on your character;
Costume accessories and costume if made or purchased;
Deodorant;
Cover Up (over costume);
Towel(s);
Refillable water bottle;
Extra socks, stockings or tights;
Extra footwear if needed; and
Copy of your script and practice CD.
ABSOLUTELY NO GUM!!

Recommended

- Money for food and/or snacks or a packed lunch. Be smart and sensible about food and snacks. If your student soils his/her costume with food or drink, you will be responsible for cleaning costs or replacement.
- Books, games, schoolwork to do during down time.
- All students should wear undergarments to the theater unless they have been instructed otherwise. They may be changing in front of other students or wearing rented costumes and props.
- Student does not eat or drink anything that is blue, red or purple before arriving for rehearsals or performances.
- If students are singing, particularly leads, pack plenty of Throat Coat, Emergen-C, etc.
- Electronics in the Greenroom will be allowed only at the discretion of the Director.
